

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SULPHUR SPRINGS, MONTANA, REQUESTING THE COUNTY ELECTION ADMINISTRATOR CONDUCT THE 2019 ELECTION(S) OF CITY OFFICIALS BY MAIL BALLOT.

WHEREAS, Title 13, Chapter 19 of the Montana Code allows for the conduct of elections by mail ballot; and

WHEREAS, 13-19-202 MCA allows a political subdivision, by resolution, to request the County Election Administrator conduct elections by mail ballot; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes a mail ballot to be both economically and administratively feasible; and

WHEREAS, THE City Council desires the ballots be mailed as close to the last legally required date as possible.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The City of White Sulphur Springs hereby requests the Meagher County Clerk and Recorder , as Election Administrator, use mail ballots to conduct the City's primary election, if necessary, on September 10, 2019, and its general election on November 5, 2019.

The City additionally requests the Election Administrator mail the ballots no sooner than the 19th day before the election.


